

Wheelchair Rock Cod Derby Directions

The Monterey Bay Veterans, Inc. – Sports Rehab Center
32K Cannery Row (at the Breakwater Cove Marina) in Monterey, CA 93940

From Highway 1 exit on Del Monte Avenue; pass by Fisherman's Wharf (on your right)
Stay right and proceed through the tunnel. As you exit the tunnel, stay in the right hand lane. Take the first right, Foam Street, and stay in the right hand lane again because you need to turn right again onto Cannery Row almost immediately. Drive down a slight hill and into a large parking lot at the base of the Coast Guard Jetty. (You'll be getting excited as you see the bay and lots of boats at anchor.) Our headquarters is on the waterside of the two-story building that also houses a delicatessen, a restaurant, and a kayak rental shop.
